Budget

Review of the SAC budget. We currently have \$2,442.34 left in our budget for this academic year.

Ms. Campbell had two teacher requests

Madame Nelson had asked for erasers and markers for the little dry erase boards (\$70 or \$80)

Mr. Mac would like items for a hydraulics activity with the grade 8's; glue guns, glue sticks and drill bits (\$170.00)

Michelle had asked if a form was used. Michelle requested that they fill out a form for tracking purposes. Gillian will request that a form is completed. The asks were made last minute at a staff meeting this afternoon so that is why they were not filled out to begin with.

Michelle asked if everyone agreed and she would put forward a motion. Michelle made a motion to fulfill these two asks; white board accessories and the grade 8 science project requirements. With purchasing as soon as possible. Motion was seconded. Everyone is in favour. Michelle moved the motion. Ms. Campbell will follow up with the teachers.

Principal Ferguson continued to discuss the grants. Student support grant has to be spent by June 30th. \$5291.00(three sets of jerseys; hockey, girls' and boys' basketball). Balance of \$2200.00 left to spend.

Healthy school grant has been used for guest speakers but only cost about 300.00 as cost was shared with AJ. Smeltzer. Hammock bought for learning center. Leaves about 4000.00 for other things maybe some supplies for the Lion's den. Perhaps buying paint for the bathrooms and with some positive messages. Purchase of water bottles for students. Needs to be spent by March 31st.

Michelle asked if we had gotten some warm weather carts of items to be used by the students outside. Principal Ferguson stated not at this time.

Principal Ferguson suggested to ask the students what they wanted.

Michelle suggested to have our last meeting in person on April 25th as the restrictions will be lifted on March 21.

Principal Ferguson has not heard about what the school will look like. Delay deciding for sure until our March 28th meeting. Most are in favour if everything allows us to see each other in person for the first time in two years.
