What will the school day look like for students?

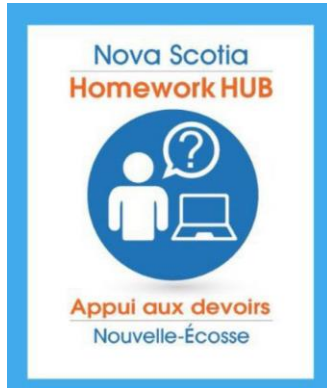
Students will
