Principal Ferguson outlined that prior to the most recent school shutdown there was remaining monies available for use from the school budget at the end of the fiscal year. Admin group felt that it would be well spent to focus on Math improvement among the grade 7 & 8 students. Thus they hired subs to come in and teach one on one to students that were identified by staff who would benefit from the additional help. Pre-tests were completed but unfortunately post-test were not completed prior to the school closure. However staff did state that they noted definite improvement amongst those students who received the one on one teachings.

At the end of February the school community benefited from some cultural learning presentations.

Admin had been working with Theresa Muise, LT's Aboriginal Student Support Worker, on monthly presentations that were presented to students every Tuesday prior to the school closure.

Online learning was going well with approximately 90-95% attendance. Throughout online learning teachers identified students that did require additional supports with on line learning. Some chrome books were loaned to students for at home use to be able to perform online learning.

The last PD day was spent looking at curriculum for Grade 7 & 8's. The next school year will see a one-hour integrated learning block for all grades.

Staff are working on applying for various grants that will benefit students at LT.

There will be staff changes for the next school year. Prinicipal Ferguson preferred to wait to be able to notify the entire school community but did outline that he will continue on as Principal of LT in a permanent position next year. There will be the same number of homerooms as this year.

Vice-Principal Doucette shared that a power point orientation package and a google classroom event was being developed for incoming Grade 6 students who are not able to

benefit from in person orientation. Additionally the possibility of a google meet for parent orientation is being evaluated as well.

- At Home Learning

As mentioned at home learning was going well. As per the government announcement on Friday the school had reached out to students who may have had extra needs not being able to be met at home and they will be welcomed back to the school on Wednesday, June 2. The news of the transition back to in class was just made hours prior to our meeting so this wasn't discussed as it was too new. But the feedback for online system this year as opposed to last year was a vast improvement.

- SSP

The student success planning that is currently being focused on includes literacy goals and student well-being.

Nothing new was noted in this area as a result of the school closure that had occurred. Not all classes were able to complete the student survey's prior to current closure.

- New Business

Jennifer Roy suggested adding SAC information to parent orientation packages to ensure that we have equal representatives on the SAC for next year.

- Next Meeting: Next Year

Principal Ferguson has tentatively scheduled meeting dates for next year. Once our first meeting in the new school year occurs we will confirm those dates. October 25<sup>th</sup> was suggested as a first meeting but chair suggested an earlier date in order to ensure that our code of contact had it is yearly review and approval prior to annual October deadline. September 27<sup>th</sup> will be the first meeting of the new school year.

Michelle thanked everyone for their volunteer commitment and participation in this year's SAC as this was our last meeting for the current school year.
